# Budget 2015-16 main feature

### 1- Receipts

- Total revenue receipts of 2015-16 are estimated to be Rs. 25777.67 crore.
- Total tax revenue receipts in 2015-16 are estimated to be Rs.14989.57 crore as against B.E 2014-15 of Rs. 12157.26 crore, showing an increase of 23.30 percent.
- Total Non Tax revenue receipts in 2015-16 are estimated to be Rs. 10788.11 crore.
- Total receipts in 2015-16 are estimated to be Rs. 32310.07 crore as against Rs. 29825.16 crore in financial year 2014-15 BE.

### 2- Expenditure

- Total expenditure is 2015-16 is estimated to be Rs.32693.64 crore as against Rs. 30353.78 crore in financial year 2014-15 BE.
- Total Non-Plan expenditure in 2015-16 is estimated to be Rs. 21059.15 crore, which is 64.41 percent of total expenditure. This shows an increase of 12.76 percent against B.E of Rs. 18676.55 crore in 2014-15.
- Total Plan expenditure is estimated to be Rs. 11634.49 crore in Financial Year 2015-16.

#### 3-Fiscal Indicators

 Budget estimates of 2015-16 show a revenue surplus, which is in conformity of FRBM Act targets. This means total revenue expenditure of the State Government is estimated to be less than the estimated revenue receipts.  Fiscal deficit has been estimated to the tune of Rs. 4101.78 crore, which is 2.63 percent of GSDP. This is well within the FRBM target of 3 percent.

## **4-Other Highlights**

- Budget provision for 38<sup>th</sup> National games to be held in Uttarakhand State has been made.
- "Rajya Andonlankari Kalyan Kosh" will be established.
- Budget provision has been made in "Mukhya Mantri Vridha Mahila Poshan Yojna" For improving health and nutrition, status of old women.
- Children disabled by birth will be given Rs. 500 per month till 18 years age.
- Budget provision has been made to stop out migration from hills by linking villages with roads "Mera Gaon Meri Sadak Yojana".
- "Corpus Fund" for villages having population more than 500 in hills districts and 5000 in plain districts will be setup for construction/reconstruction of drains, roads, water supply etc.
- Budget provision has been made for "Mere Bujurug Mere Tirth Yojana".
- To develop awareness amongst school children about trees and environment "Hamara School Hamara Vriksha Yojana" has been introduced.

- "Manav-Vanar Sangharash Neunikaran Yojana" has been started to minimize damages done by monkeys to crops and other losses.
- Veterinary Colleges will be established in Gangolihat, Champawat, Bajpur and Jakholi.
- Multipurpose Artisan Museum in the memory of Munshi Hari Prasad Tamta will be established in Garurabanj, Almora.
- Folk singer/ artist welfare fund will be established.
- Schools for preservation of traditional vocal instruments will be established near Pethshal, Almora and near Tehri Lake.
- One time grant will be given for Rang Sanskrti Museum situated in Dharchula and Pangti museum in Munshiayari.
- "Veer Chandra Singh Garhwali Yojana" will revamped and for 20% quota shall be established for women.
- "Master Craftsman Yojana" will be initiated for promotion of traditional handicraft, Hathkaragha in hills area.
- "Chal khal Yojana" will be started for recharging of water sources and watershed management.
- Hospital Beds will be reserved for senior citizens.
- Animal reproduction centre on the lines of Kalasi veterinary centre will be established in Nariyal village of Champawat district.
- Science Centre and Park will be established in Almora.

- Viyapari Kalyan Kosh would be established for welfare of small traders.
- A Fund of Rs. 10 crore would be created for "Rajya Andolankari".
- 20% reservation for women in Homegaurds and PRD will be made.
- Sitavani near Ramnagar will to be developed as "Maharishi Valmiki theerth".
- For proper traffic management a tunnel will be constructed in Almora.
- Working group will be constituted to study the feasibility of Metro like project connecting Dehradun-Rishikesh-Haridwar and Kathgodam-Haldwani-Lalkuan-Rudrapur.
- Valmiki School will be opened each in Kumaon and Garhwal Region.
- Monetary help of Rs. 2 lakh would be provided to women victims of acid attack.
- "Indira Priya Drashani Kam Kaji Mahila Yojana" would be initiated to link women with self employment.
- Uttarakhand Gorillas will be included in Eco-task Force.
- "Eco Gram Samooh" and Eco Park to be established in every district.

- Bonus will be given for production of Madua, Anardana, Fafar and Chaulai.
- Permission will be granted for cutting of Pine (Cheer) trees in private agricultural lands.
- One time grant will be granted to Milk Society for establishing chilling plants.
- Govt. will provide subsidy to Milk Federation an interest payable on their bank loan.
- Physiotherapy rehabilitation Centre will be established in Pithoragarh, Haldwani and Dehradun.
- New Medical College will be established in Bhagwanpur and Pithoragarh.
- School of language will be opened in Doon University and Almora Campus of Kumaon University.
- To establish the identity of the State the Government will select a state song and head gear.
- Corpus Fund for Journalists and their dependents would be increased to one and half time.
- State will launch a contributory pension scheme for state journalists.
- Dayara Bugayal (Uttarkashi), Khaliya Top (Munshiyari) will be developed as a skiing centre.

- A contributory insurance scheme for Advocates of Uttarakhand will be launched.
- Uttarakhand's only Women Government College at Haldwani will be developed as Indira Priyadarshni govt. college of commerce.
